It is an independent and economic than certification system for sustainable production, democratic organization, fair trade and self-management. It is the only certification label made from the producers. It is therefore a proposal for direct producer-consumer relationship that comes from Marco Coscione the South, and not a proposal imposed from the North"

A final revision of the SPP's New General Standard is being made, especially in terms of the definition of Small Producers' Organizations. There has been an interesting exchange of opinions of this definition from the Second Meeting of the SPP in Ecuador, at the end of last year. The challenge is to find a good balance between the interests of the smaller producers and realities of each region and product. We will publish it in a maximum period of one month. Stay tuned!
