## 1. INTRODUCTION

1. This document is published by the non-profit organization *SPP Global*, which is an abbreviation of *Símbolo de Pequeños Productores Global A.C.* (Small Producers' Symbol Global). *SPP Global* formerly had the legal name of *Fundación de Pequeños Productores, A.C., FUNDEPPO*.
2. The official language for all documents associated with the Small Producers' Symbol is Spanish. In the case of any doubt arising from a translated version, the Spanish document shall be used as the only valid version.
3. This document cancels and replaces:

5. These procedures fulfill the ISO/IEC Guide 65: 1996 General Requirements for Bodies Operating Product Certification Systems and the Guidelines from the International Accreditation Forum (IAF).
6. This document specifies the regulations, fees and basis for calculating certification and registration costs for the Small Producers' Symbol, with regard to the costs involved in certification, registration, annual enrollment and the use of the Small Producers' Symbol certification.
7. The fees for Small Producers' Symbol certification and registration services depend on the specific fees of those Certification Entities authorized by *SPP Global*.
8. These Regulations apply to Small Producers' Organizations as well as to Final Buyers, Collective Trading Companies owned by Small Producers' Organizations, and also Intermediaries and Maquila Companies, associated with the Small Producers' Symbol.
9. These regulations have been approved by the Board of Directors of *SPP Global (Símbolo de Pequeños Productores Global, A.C.)* and are subject to changes.
10. Section 3 of this document presents the fees and basis for calculating costs for Small Producers' Organizations, and Section 4 includes the fees and basis for calculating costs for Final Buyers, Collective Trading Companies owned by Small Producers' Organizations, Intermediaries and Maquila Companies. Section 5 presents specifications regarding the general provisions for payments to be made.

### 3. COSTS FOR SMALL PRODUCERS' ORGANIZATIONS

#### 3.1. Introduction

Small Producers' Organizations pay three types of fees:

- a. **Application Fee<sup>1</sup>:** This fee covers all expenses incurred by SPP Global in carrying out the Eligibility Process for new applicants and it is equivalent to 150 U.S. dollars. This Application Fee is independent of the Annual Membership fee and is payable only when applying for SPP Certification for the first time.<sup>2</sup>
- b. **Certification Cost.** This fee covers all expenses incurred by the Certification Entity in conducting the certification process.
- c. **Annual Membership Fee.** This fee covers all of *SPP Global's* expenses for maintenance, development, quality control of the standards system, certification and registration, and the dissemination and promotion of *Símbolo de Pequeños Productores* and its market.

#### 3.2. SPP Certification Procedures

The costs of SPP certification will depend in the first instance on the **type of procedure** that the Certification Entity (CE) will apply, according to the Certification Cycle (See SPP Certification Procedures).

The main Procedures are:

- a. **Normal Document-based Procedure**
- b. **Complete On-Site Procedure**

#### 3.3. Certification Costs

- a. For the Normal Document-based Procedure, the following table of workdays is used:

- b. For the Normal Document-based Procedure the activities to be carried out for certification are the following:
  - i. Document-based Evaluation
  - ii. Evaluation Report
  - iii. Examination
  - iv. Cost of Control Evaluations
- c. For the Complete On-Site Procedure, the following activities have been established:

- i. Preparation for visit
  - ii. Inspection of main offices
  - iii. Inspection of complementary sites (offices, warehouses, processing plants)
  - iv. Sample of Small Producers' Organizations
  - v. Inspection of Production Units
  - vi. Preparation of Inspection Report
  - vii. Examination
  - viii. Days may be added or subtracted in accordance with various Complementary Factors
- d. To establish the number of workdays required for the Complete On-Site Procedure, it is necessary to apply the Annex 1 Table for calculation of workdays involved in the Complete On-Site Procedures, from the "Guidelines for defining the Work Plan for Evaluating Compliance."
- e. In specific cases, if an organization produces different products but is interested in only including one product in its certification, it may report this in its request to the Certification Entity, for the payment corresponding to the number of members that produce the product to be included in the certification, exclusively when the Document-based Procedure is applicable.<sup>3</sup>
- f. Payments made for this purpose will be non-refundable, independently of the results of the Document-based or On-Site Evaluation.
- g. When it is necessary to complete a Document-based Procedure by a field visit, the CE will make a proposal for the costs involved, based exclusively on the workdays involved in the complementary field visit for corroborating the missing information.
- h. The final cost of certification will depend on the rates charged by the specific Certification Entity<sup>4</sup> for an evaluation of the Small Producers' Symbol standards and the possible combination of this evaluation with a review of other certification programs.<sup>5</sup>
- i. The workdays for the On-Site evaluation do not include the Evaluator's daily expenses<sup>6</sup> (transportation, lodging, and food). These expenses are to be negotiated separately between the organization that is to be certified and the Certification Entity. It is possible that these expenses will be paid directly, in common agreement, partially or completely, by the organization to be certified.
- j. The costs of the certification are to be paid to the Certification Entity in question. Please confirm the bank information for this Certification Entity before making a bank deposit.

### 3.4. Annual Membership Fee

- a. The **Annual Membership Fee** is the total of the following two components:
  - i. A Basic Fee that depends on the number of producer members that produce the products to be included in the certification of the Small Producers' Organization (in

USD).<sup>7</sup> This revenue will be included in SPP Global's general revenue and administered by its Board of Directors.

- i. A Volume Fee corresponding to 0.15% of the value of SPP products sold by the Small Producers' Organization in the past annual cycle<sup>8</sup>.

An annual report must be sent to SPP Global detailing all sales of SPP products (domestic or export), the volume fee will be calculated based on exported volume; domestic sales will be used for statistical purposes.

- b. In specific cases, by means of written request, if an organization produces different products but is interested in only including one product in the certification, it may ask SPP Global that its payment correspond only to the number of partners that produce the product to be included in the certification.
- c. The Annual Membership Fee is paid once a year to SPP Global “*Símbolo de Pequeños Productores Global, Asociación Civil*” (see annexed bank information), on the basis of annual sales reports on the corresponding forms.

### 3.5. SPP User's Fee

- a. SPP-certified Small Producers' Organizations have the right to use the SPP on final products for the domestic market, without any additional payment.
- b. In the case of final products sold by an SPP-certified Small Producers' Organization to a Buyer for the domestic or international market, see the section entitled “Cost of the Use of the Small Producers' Symbol” (4.4).

## 4. COSTS FOR FINAL BUYERS, COLLECTIVE TRADING COMPANIES OWNED BY SMALL PRODUCERS' ORGANIZATIONS, INTERMEDIARIES AND MAQUILA COMPANIES

### 4.1. INTRODUCTION

Final Buyers (Buyers), Collective Trading Companies owned by Small Producers' Organizations (CC), Intermediaries and Maquila Companies (INT, MAQ) pay these types of fees:

- a. **Application Fee<sup>9</sup>:** This fee covers all expenses incurred by SPP Global in carrying out the Eligibility Process for new applicants and it is equivalent to 150 U.S. dollars. This Application Fee is independent of the Annual Membership fee and is payable only when applying for SPP Certification for the first time.<sup>10</sup>

- b. **Registration Fee:** Covers all expenses incurred by the Certification Entity in conducting the Registration process.
- c. **Annual Membership Fee:** equivalent to US \$500 (only Final Buyers)<sup>11</sup>.
- d. **SPP User's Fee:** (Only Final Buyers) The reference to "use" refers to both the use of the Small Producers' Symbol logo in any of its versions, and also the use of the reference to Small Producers' Symbol certification. The User's Fee is paid in relation to the value of products purchased under SPP certification.

#### **4.2. SPP REGISTRATION FEE**

The costs of SPP registration will depend in the first instance on the **type of procedure** that the Certification Entity (CE) will apply, according to the Registration Cycle (See SPP Certification Procedures).

The main Procedures are:

- a. **Normal Document-based Procedure**
- b. **Complete On-Site Procedure**

#### **4.3. REGISTRATION COSTS**

- a. For the **Normal Document-based Procedure**, the following table of workdays is used:

- b. For the **Normal Document-based** the activities to be carried out for certification are the following:
  - i. Document-based Evaluation
  - ii. Evaluation Report
  - iii. Examination
  - iv. Cost of Control Evaluations
- c. For the **Complete On-Site Procedure**, the following activities have been established:
  - i. Preparation for visit
  - ii. Inspection of main offices

- iii. Inspection of complementary sites (offices, warehouses, processing plants)
  - iv. Preparation of Inspection Report
  - v. Examination
  - vi. Days may be added or subtracted in accordance with various Complementary Factors
- d. To verify the days required by the CE for each type of work, see the information in the Annex 1 Table for calculation of workdays involved in the Complete On-Site Procedure, from the “Guidelines for defining the Work Plan for Evaluating Compliance.”
  - e. When it is necessary for a Document-based Procedure to be complemented by a field visit, the CE will make a proposal for the costs involved, based exclusively on the expenses incurred in the complementary field visit for corroborating the missing information.
  - f. The final cost of Registration may vary due to different factors, such as the rate of a specific Certification Entity<sup>12</sup> for an evaluation of the Small Producers' Symbol standards, and the possible combination of this evaluation with a review of other registration processes.<sup>13</sup>
  - g. Payments made for this purpose will be non-refundable, independently of the results of the Document-based or On-Site Evaluation.
  - h. The workdays for the On-Site evaluation do not include the Evaluator's<sup>14</sup> daily expenses (transportation, lodging, and food). These expenses are to be negotiated separately between the entity that is to be registered and the Certification Entity. It is possible that these expenses are paid directly, in common agreement, partially or completely, by the entity that is to be registered itself.
  - i. The costs of the registration are to be paid to the Certification Entity in question. Please confirm the necessary information for this Certification Entity before making a bank deposit.

#### **4.4. Annual Membership Fee**

- a. Final Buyers pay an Annual Membership fee of US \$500<sup>7</sup>.
- b. Annual Membership fee for microenterprises (“SPP Final Buyers” or “SPP Small Buyers”), is determined considering the total value of SPP transactions made during the previous year (or estimated transactions during the first year), according to the following table:

#### **4.5. Small Producers' Symbol User's Fee**

- a. In the case of purchases of raw materials or semi-final products, the cost of the use of the Small Producers' Symbol for Final Buyers is a User's Fee by volume of 1.75% of the value of the SPP minimum price (including the SPP Incentive and Organic Recognition) of the purchases made by the Final Buyer, corresponding to their sale under Small Producers' Symbol certification.
- b. In the case of final products produced in the country of origin, the following user's fee must be paid:
  - i. Three-fourths of 1.75% of the value of the purchase of the set of SPP-certified ingredients (not including packaging, processing, etc.) when the product is purchased directly from a certified SPO.
  - ii. 1.75% of the value of the purchase of the set of SPP-certified ingredients (not including packaging, processing, etc.) when the product is purchased from an Intermediary or Maquila Company from the country of origin.
- c. Final Buyers deciding not to put the SPP logo on their consumer packaging must cover a fee, complementary to the usage fee, equivalent to 0.25% of the purchase value. Final Buyers must verify with SPP that this complementary fee has been assigned for promotion of the SPP, for example, promotional activities, brochures and information on the internet, related to SPP products.
- d. User's fees do not need to be paid by Buyers who purchase final products of Small Producers' Organizations from the same country, with the SPP label for the domestic market, if the following conditions are met:
  - If used exclusively for selling to final consumers.
  - If its name or brand is not used on the product.
- e. In the specific case of bananas, the payment of fees will be made according to the following payment scheme:
  - 1. During the first year following Registration, only 33% of the total fee will be paid.
  - 2. During the second year following Registration, 66% of the total fee will be paid. After the second year following Registration, 100% of the total fee will be paid.

- f. Only in the case in which it is not completely clear for what part of the product purchased is the Small Producers' Symbol to be used, the fee paid will be based on an estimate of the part for which the Small Producers' Symbol (SPP) will be used. Such estimates may only be used after obtaining authorization, in response to a request made with due justification. If authorization is granted, a tentative payment will be made, and when the final amount of the product for which the SPP will be used is determined, an adjustment will be made on the next payment corresponding to actual use.
- g. Payment of the User's Fee is to be made every three months, with respect to the volume of the product purchased (to be sold) under the Small Producers' Symbol during the period just concluded.
- h. User's fees will be paid to *SPP Global* ("*Símbolo de Pequeños Productores Global, Asociación Civil*") (see annexed bank information).

## 5. GENERAL TERMS OF PAYMENT

- a. The costs mentioned in this document do not include possible value-added taxes or other types of taxes.
- b. The money transfer commissions of the bank are to be paid by the payer.
- c. The time period during which payment may be made consists of a maximum of 21 calendar days, beginning on the date on which *SPP Global* sends the form with the payment item and amount.
- d. After 21 calendar days, a monthly interest rate of 5% will be charged. This does not mean the time period established for making the payment has been extended.
- e. Expenses generated by refunds made due to deposits made erroneously to *SPP Global's* bank account will be paid by the sender.
- f. Regarding payments to *SPP Global*, they may be made in the following three currencies: US dollar, Mexican peso, or Euro.
- g. For transfers and deposits within Mexico, please use *SPP Global's* bank account in Mexican pesos (see *SPP Global's* bank details annexed).
- h. In the case of payments to *SPP Global* through international bank transfers, *SPP Global's* bank account in US dollars or its bank account in Euros may be used.
- i. If Euros are used to pay *SPP Global*, the amount to be paid must be equivalent to the specified amount in dollars, using the exchange rate specified on the day the payment is made, as published by the European Commission: [http://ec.europa.eu/budget/inforeuro/index.cfm?fuseaction=currency\\_historique&currency=201&Language=en](http://ec.europa.eu/budget/inforeuro/index.cfm?fuseaction=currency_historique&currency=201&Language=en)
- j. If Mexican pesos are used to pay *SPP Global*, the amount to be paid must be equivalent to the specified amount in dollars, using the exchange rate specified on the day the payment is made, as published by the Bank of Mexico at: <http://www.banxico.org.mx/portal-mercado-cambiaro/index.html>
- k. Commissions: The sender will need to take responsibility for paying for the commissions corresponding to the transaction, the amount of which will depend on the particular Banking

Institution. The amount to be deposited in the receiving account (SPP accounts) must be received in full. If not, the remaining amount due will be added to the next invoice.

- I. IVA: In the case of deposits made within Mexico, and in accordance with Mexico's fiscal provisions, all payments must include the withholding Added-Value Tax (*Impuesto sobre el Valor Agregado—IVA*).<sup>15</sup> The payment amount made in any currency must be equivalent to the percentage currently established by Mexico's Tax Administration System (*Sistema de Administración Tributaria—SAT*) of the net amount to be deposited, in accordance with an invoice.
- m. After a deposit or transfer is made to *SPP Global's* bank account, the receipt should be uploaded into D-SPP and *SPP Global's* operations office should be notified so that the payment will be acknowledged.
