1. You make purchases according to either scenario A or scenario B:

Scenario A:

My company purchases SPP products totaling no more than 100,000 USD per year: I can buy from an unlimited number of SPP suppliers and perform an unlimited number of transactions.



Scenario B:

• My company purchases SPP products totaling no more than 150,000 USD per year: I can buy from up to 3 SPP suppliers and perform up to 5 transactions per year.



2. Commit to ensure traceability of SPP products up to point of sale





3. If I wish to sell SPP single-ingredient products, I cannot mix them with other products that are not SPP certified.





Check all details: Chapter 6.6 Origin Criteria - SPP General Standard



4. Multi-ingredient products, such as chocolate, must contain at least 50% SPP-certified ingredients based on total product. (Percentage to be increased gradually)

5. I must ensure proper SPP logo usage, i.e., always use authorized versions and applications.







6. I must pay SPOs the SPP minimum price set for the product(s) I buy.

If I buy through an SPP Final Buyer, this SPP Final Buyer will be in charge of paying the SPO.







7. If I buy directly from a Small Producers' Organization, I must agree to buy from them for at least 3 years and hold (virtual) annual follow-up meetings with them.

Small Buyer Registration

1. I reach an agreement with an SPP Final Buyer (FB) or an SPP Small Producers' Organization (SPO) for them to endorse my application and complete all steps needed for my registration as a Small Buyer (S-Buyer)








2. I fill out and sign an SPP Small Buyer Affidavit, agreeing to comply with all established requirements.







3. My counterparty, either a Final Buyer or a Small Producers' Organization, also fills out and signs a similar Affidavit.





4. I submit a Small Buyer registration request to SPP Global, enclosing the Small Buyer Affidavit I filled and signed. My counterparty (FB or SPO) also submits its filled and signed affidavit.







5. SPP Global reviews submitted documents. If everything is right, I will be asked to pay my annual membership fee. Once payment is received, SPP Global will authorize me to operate as an SPP Small Buyer and I will be delivered a registration certificate featuring my SPP ID





6. I am now officially an SPP Small Buyer and can start using the SPP label!





7. Every year, I will fill out and submit a report form with SPP products bought and sold annually.





7 a) If I registered through a Final Buyer, we must both agree who will prepare and submit required SPP product sales/purchases reports.



7 b) If I registered through a Small Producers' Organization, we must both report annual purchases / sales of SPP products.



8. I pay my SPP Global *Annual Membership Fee* at the end of each one-year operating cycle, according to the amount of SPP products I bought.

AMOUNT OF SPP PRODUCTS PURCHASED (USD)	FEE (USD)
Greater than \$ 80,000.00 up to \$ 100,000.00	\$400
Greater than \$60,000.00 up to \$80,000.00	\$300
Greater than \$ 30,000.00 up to \$ 60,000.00	\$200
Greater than \$ 20,000.00 up to \$ 30,000.00	\$150
Greater than \$ 10,000.00 up to \$ 20,000.00	\$100
Less than or equal to \$ 10,000.00	\$75







Keep in mind

If I buy SPP products through an SPP Final Buyer, I do not need to pay any *User Fee*; the Final Buyer is to pay that fee.





Keep in mind

If I buy directly from an SPP Small Producers'
Organization, I do have to pay SPP Global a *User*Fee in addition to my *Annual Membership Fee*.





User Fee


To calculate my *User Fee* I must multiply the total transaction amount of my SPP annual purchases (based on SPP Minimum Price) by 1.75%. As for products finished and packaged in the country of origin, multiply by 1.31%, instead.





Keep in mind

I can pay my *Annual Membership* Fee and my User Fee (if applicable) directly to SPP Global or through my counterparty, i.e., the Final Buyer or the Small Producers' Organization who endorsed my registration.







SPP Global conducts annual monitoring assessments to verify that Small Buyers keep their commitments and fulfill their duties.





Each year, SPP Global will randomly select at least 10% of registered Small Buyers for monitoring assessments. If I am selected, I will be willing to collaborate. This should not generate any additional fees.





If anomalies are detected during this monitoring, I will agree to undergo a Complete Remote Evaluation conducted by a Certification Entity.





The cost of this evaluation is to be paid by me, the Small Buyer, and/or my counterparty (FB, SPO), depending on which party was at fault and according to the initial agreements we made.
